1. Artists must be aged 25 years or younger to enter.
2. Artists must live in, attend school in, or have a strong connection to Glenorchy to enter
The Glenorchy municipality includes Austins Ferry, Berriedale, Chigwell, Claremont, Collinsvale, Derwent Park, Dowsing Point, Glenorchy, Glenlusk, Goodwood, Granton, Lutana, Montrose, Moonah, Rosetta and West Moonah.
3. Each artist can submit one artwork only.
4. This exhibition does not provide artist fees or charges.
5. If there are any issues with the artwork (for example size, complexity etc) which require negotiation, the MAC Visual Arts Program Officer will get in touch to resolve these with you.
